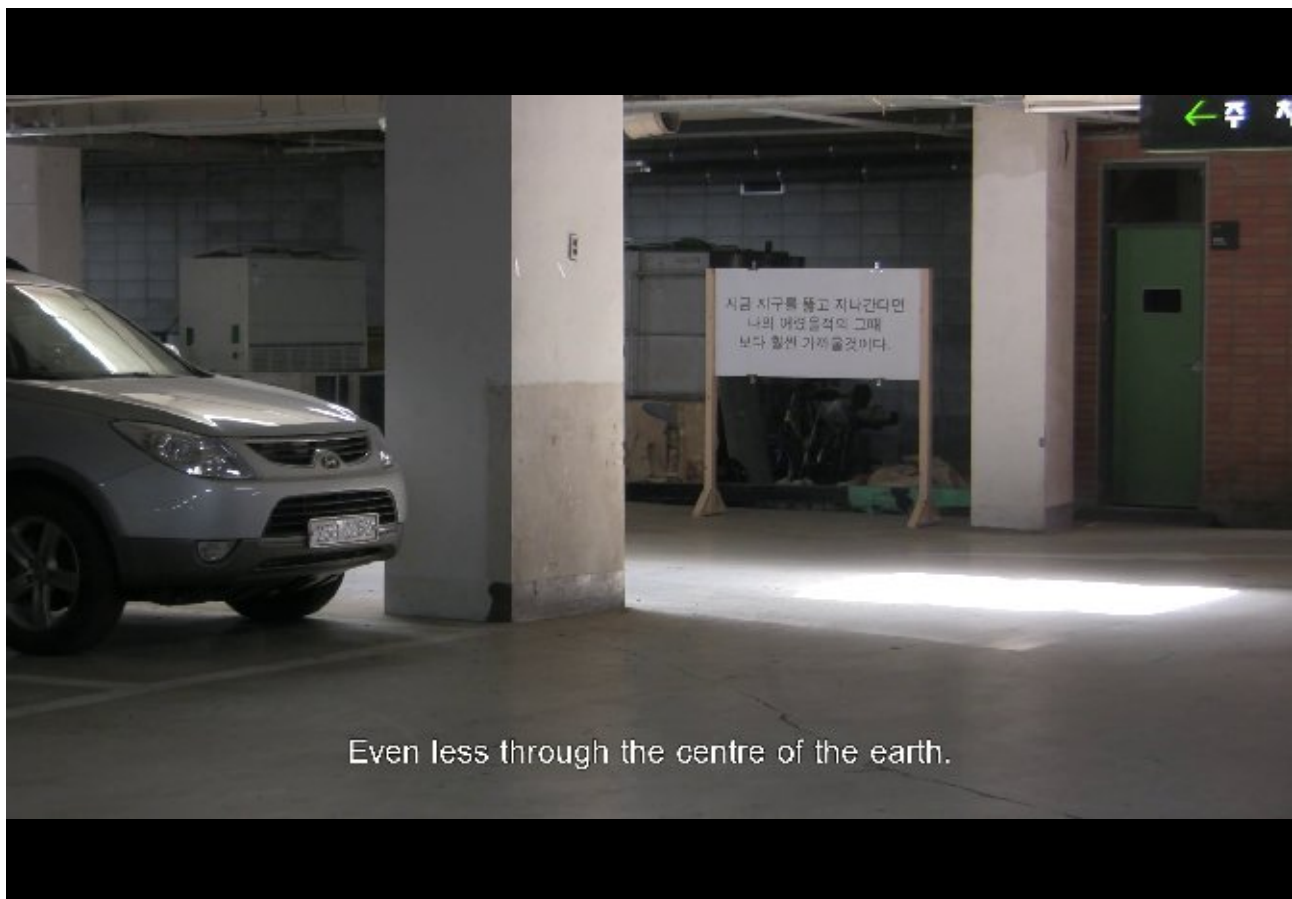
And this is what I made – a short film entitled *Seoul digging*, which tells the story of my childhood dream of digging to Australia.
